

PUPIL PREMIUM SUMMARY

2016-2017

Early Years Pupil Premium is an allocation of additional funding provided to schools to support specific groups of children who are vulnerable to possible underachievement. These include children who have been looked after by the Local Authority, adopted children, children of Armed Services personnel and children from qualifying low income families. The intended effect of the funding is to accelerate progress, raise attainment and support the pupils in the participation of activities in the wider curriculum.

In 2016-17 the Nursery School's additional income from Pupil Premium was £8439 and our expenditure was £7842, spent as follows:

£855	Resources to support small group work – nurture groups, speech and language.	PPG children making expected progress in prime areas of learning.
